1 INTRODUCTION

A pressure washer can be used to keep a variety of things you own looking their best, and setting up your pressure washer is a snap.



Read the manual first

2 READ WASHER'S OPERATOR'S MANUAL

Before doing anything else, read your pressure washer's operator's manual. You're going to use your pressure washer a lot, so take some time to familiarize yourself with its parts and controls.



Checking oil level

3 CHECK ENGINE OIL LEVEL

Always check the engine oil level before starting your pressure washer to prevent failure or damage. If necessary, add oil but don't overfill the engine crankcase. Refer to both the pressure washer and engine operator's manuals for oil recommendations and filling instructions.



Checking the hoses

4 CHECK HOSES, O-RINGS AND SCREENS

After you've checked the oil level, check the pressure washer's hoses, screens and o-rings for signs of damage and replace if necessary.
